'ANANDADHARA' - COMPLETE DAY CARE CENTRES WITH EDUCATION, CARE & NUTRITION

Naihati New Life Society is running 10 ECDI center in different districts of West Bengal. Naihati New Life Society, a non-profit organization, has recently opened three ECDI center to provide quality education to children from underprivileged families who cannot afford to enroll their children in private schools along with a complete day care canters with care & nutrition to all the deprived children of this village. We have recently opened 2 new ECDI center one at Murshibad and another one at Minakhan. The objective of opening this ECDI center is to provide affordable education to children from underprivileged families and to give them an opportunity to learn and develop their skills in a nurturing and supportive environment.

SHELTER HOME FOR STREET CHILDREN FOR GIRLS –

Our Orphanage for orphan street girls had turned 7 this year. The Open Shelter for girls is located in Naihati, a small town in West Bengal, India. The shelter has a capacity of 30 girls, between the ages of 6 and 18 years. The shelter is run by a team of dedicated staff and volunteers who provide round-the-clock care and support to the girls. The shelter provides a safe and secure living environment, nutritious meals, access to education, and healthcare services. The shelter also provides counselling and life skills training to help the girls build confidence and prepare for a better future. Along with their studies they also learn extra-curricular activities like dance, singing, drawing, computer learning, etc.



3 CULTURAL COMPETITION -

Every year Naihati New Life Society arranges cultural competition programs and events that are free of cost to the public. This is done to encourage greater participation and involvement in cultural activities among the local community and to promote the cultural heritage of Bengal. Such cultural programs may include musical performances, dance recitals, drama shows, poetry readings, and cultural festivals. These programs may feature local artists or even renowned artists from outside the region, providing audiences with an opportunity to witness and appreciate various art forms. Naihati New Life Society every year organizes free cultural programs to promote cultural activities and traditions in the region.



REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH RIGHTS & EDUCATION FOR YOUNG-ADULTS-

The Reproductive Health Rights and Education for Young-Adults camp arranged by the Naihati New Life Society at Harishpur, Satyanarayanpur and Mathurakunda villages of North and South 24 Parganas were aimed at educating young women about reproductive health, rights, and services. The camp was a one-day event and was attended by near about 300 women. The sessions were led by trained healthcare professionals who provided the attendees with accurate and up-to-date information on each topic. In addition to the sessions, the camp also provided free educational reproductive health services such as pregnancy tests, STI testing, and distribution of free contraceptives. Attendees were encouraged to ask questions and seek advice on any reproductive health concerns they may have had. Such camps can play a crucial role in raising awareness about reproductive health, providing access to services, and improving the overall health and well-being of women.





FREE EYE CAMP AND SPECTACLES DISTRIBUTION -

The eye camp had arranged by Naihati New Life Society for poor villagers residing in Barrackpore I block to provide them with access to eye check-ups and treatment. The objective of the eye camp was to provide free eye check-ups and treatment to poor villagers who cannot afford to visit a regular eye doctor. The eye camp offered a range of services, including eye examinations, cataract surgeries, eye drop distributions, and free eyeglasses to those who needed them. The eye camp was well-attended by a large number of poor villagers from the surrounding areas. Volunteers from the organization worked tirelessly to ensure that each individual was given proper attention and care. The eye camp organized by us was a great success and provided much-needed relief to the poor villagers who otherwise would not have had access to eye care facilities. The patients who had cataract on their eyes also got free cataract surgery

CLOTHES DISTRIBUTION

During the Durga Puja festival, the Naihati New Life Society distributes clothes to residents of old age homes, orphanages, and street children, spreading joy and warmth. This initiative aims to provide new clothing items to those in need, ensuring they feel cherished and included during the festive season. By extending this gesture of generosity, the society uplifts spirits and promotes a sense of community and togetherness among vulnerable populations. The clothing distribution reflects the society's commitment to fostering compassion and dignity, making a positive impact on the lives of elderly individuals, orphaned children, and disadvantaged youth, enhancing their festival experience with care and support.





EDUCATIONAL CENTRES FOR SLUM & STREET CHILDREN -

The Naihati New Life Society operates educational centers for slum and street children, offering free education and drawing classes. These centers provide a safe and supportive environment where children receive basic education and develop artistic skills through drawing lessons. By offering these services at no cost, the society aims to empower underprivileged children with knowledge and creative expression, opening doors to brighter futures. The educational centers foster holistic development and instill confidence, equipping children with essential skills for personal growth and breaking the cycle of poverty. This initiative reflects the society's dedication to nurturing young minds and promoting access to education for all.

WOMEN TAILORING AND CUTTING CENTRE-

Our NGO works for the vulnerable women of our society. We empower these women by providing proper vocational trainings. In the villages of North 24 Parganas we have started a centre in which we provide tailoring training to the women by which they can earn for their livelihood. This training will help them in their future. They do not have to depend on others for money. We help in boosting the status of women through this training and by creating awareness among them. In addition to the economic benefits, the tailoring training program also helps to promote gender equality by providing women with equal opportunities for employment and entrepreneurship. The Naihati New Life Society's tailoring training program is open to women of all ages and backgrounds. The program is designed to be accessible and affordable, and participants receive hands-on training and support from experienced trainers.





SAPLINGS DISTRIBUTION PROJECT -

The Naihati New Life Society distributed 50,000 saplings of Thai jackfruit, mango, papaya, and banana to households in local villages of Barrackpore I block, free of cost. This initiative aims to promote income generation among villagers through fruit cultivation. By providing these saplings, the society empowers households to grow fruit trees, enabling them to generate additional income from fruit sales. This sustainable approach not only enhances economic opportunities but also contributes to environmental conservation and food security in the community. The distribution of diverse fruit saplings reflects the society's commitment to supporting livelihoods and fostering self-reliance among villagers.

10 NUTRITION CAMPAIGN-

The Naihati New Life Society conducted a nutrition campaign in Harishpur village of 24 Parganas North to support the health of mothers and children. The campaign focused on educating mothers about proper nutrition during pregnancy and early childhood, emphasizing the importance of balanced diets and breastfeeding. The society provided nutritional and fortified foods address supplements to deficiencies and promote healthy growth. Health screenings were conducted to identify and address any nutritional concerns. By empowering mothers with knowledge and resources, the campaign aimed to improve maternal and child health outcomes, ensuring healthier pregnancies and better nutritional practices for children in the community.





SUBSIDISED AMBULANCE FACILITY-

The Naihati New Life Society offers a subsidized ambulance facility to assist poor individuals within our society. This service provides affordable emergency transportation for those in need, ensuring timely access to medical care and hospitals. By offering this subsidized ambulance service, the society aims to bridge the gap in access to critical healthcare services for economically disadvantaged individuals. This initiative underscores the society's commitment to promoting health equity and ensuring that everyone, regardless of financial means, has the opportunity to receive necessary medical attention during emergencies. The subsidized ambulance facility serves as a vital lifeline for our community, providing essential support and care when it matters most.
